Lead and Copper Service Inventory

Dear Resident,

In conjunction with the State Lead and Copper Rule Revision, all public water systems must conduct a service lateral inventory and submit to the State by October 16, 2024. The objective of the inventory is to determine every culinary service lateral piping material and size. This will include the service lateral piping from the water main to the meter (System side), and from the meter to the inside of your residence (Customer side).

We will make every effort to obtain this information without disturbing you or entering your home. **We will not enter your home or property at any time without your consent.** In an attempt to simplify this process, we have provided a QR code below with a survey that will allow you to provide all the needed information. We will be conducting a brief Public Outreach meeting before the regularly scheduled Town Council meeting on **November 2nd, at 6:00 pm** at the Community Center. We will have a service lateral sample board there with various service lateral pipe materials that you may encounter in your home and instruction on how to identify them.

If we are unable to obtain the needed information through public record search or the QR code survey, we will attempt to reach out to you in person. We will provide 24hour notice prior to arriving at your residence and with your consent we will enter your home, locate and identify your service lateral. **We will not enter your home or property at any time without your consent.**

If you had your service lateral replaced or installed after 1989 (after 1989 lead service piping and fittings were banned on culinary system), your service lateral will not be lead.

If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to ask them during the Public Outreach meeting. We apologize for any inconvenience we may cause in this process and greatly appreciate your cooperation.
